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## Covid-19 Catch-Up Premium

School will receive the sum of **£19,120** spread over three termly payments within the 2020 / 21 academic year. This equates to £80 for each of our pupils.

In order to maximise the impact of the Covid-19 Catch-Up Premium in terms of ensuring that all children in school benefit over a longer period of time, school has:

- Allocated the sum of **£3,580** to purchase **Lexia** (a research-proven program which provides explicit, systematic, personalised learning in the six areas of reading instruction, targeting skill gaps as they emerge). We will purchase 50 3-year teacher licenses for our disadvantaged children and those with SEN. All children will benefit from the initial testing and information it will provide the class teacher plus the resources which can be used for the whole class/groups for English lessons in school or Remote Learning.
- Registered with the **National Tutoring Programme** and allocated the sum of **TBC** to pay for a Teach First graduate to deliver small group and one to one tuition (We pay 25% towards costs).
- Allocated the sum of **£1002** to pay for a **TA** to provide extra support to identified children who are not 'Year 1 Ready' three afternoons a week.
- Allocated the sum of **£4,060 per year for 3 years = £12,878** to lease **30 laptops** and **£609.50** to purchase **50 sets of headphones**, which will be allocated to pupils using the Lexia programme.
- Allocated the sum of **£97** to purchase the **Numbots** programme

In doing so, we will be able to support school's focus on:

- The basic skills of phonics, reading, English grammar, punctuation and spelling and maths within our 'recovery curriculum.'
- Providing and making effective use of instant feedback.
- Increasing levels of engagement.
- Enabling pupils to access personalised curriculums.

We will monitor the impact of the Catch-Up Premium spend through:

- Observation of whole class, small group and one to one sessions.
- Examining live data.
- Analysing how skills are applied within workbooks.
- Analysing formal assessment data.

The impact of the Catch-Up Premium will be discussed with the governing body.
