School name change

We are proud to have our Inclusion Resource pupils and staff working closely with us and are delighted their Willows classroom in main school is now in full use. At our first Governors meeting last week, we agreed to change our school name to 'Moorthorpe Primary School with Inclusion Resource'. We will check with Wakefield Council any further steps we need to take. There will be no changes to uniform, but we will look to change letterheads, signs, website etc.

Change in school hours/ times

The government have stated that from September 2023, all schools must provide a 32.5 hour offer across the week. This equates to 6.5 hours per day. We currently offer 31.67 hours per week as we open at 8:40am and school finishes at 3:00pm. Following advice from the Local Authority, it is clear that we need to extend the school day slightly.
