Year 1 & 2 Home Learning Planning Week 7 - Celebration



Weekly Reading Tasks - aim for 1 or more tasks per day

Accelerated Reader / Reading a variety of books at home. Your child should ideally share a book every day.

- Reading comprehension - can you use the story to answer the questions?
- Read the story Kipper's Birthday. Discuss how it may be similar or the same to your birthday celebration. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=heUOEHGbcnw>
- Listen to a story from David Walliams 'Elevenses' <https://www.worldofdavidwalliams.com/elevenses-catch-up/>
- Listen to a story read, [Storyline](#).
- Find a book where you can see the characters celebrating. Is it a birthday? Can you read the book to someone over the phone?

Weekly Maths Tasks- aim for 1 White Rose lesson per day

We follow the White Rose Maths scheme of work for Maths whilst we are in school, so this week we will be setting your Maths activities using White Rose Maths.

All you need to do is search the website:

Weekly Writing Tasks - aim for at least 1 per day



- Write an invitation for a celebration. This could be a birthday party, Easter celebration, christening, wedding etc.
- Create a list of all of the celebration days that you have been part of. Can you recall and write a sentence about what they remember about each. Remember what punctuation to use to make a good sentence.
- Invent a story involving a celebration. You could write it out or make a story map. Remember to use story language. How will it begin, what will happen and how will it end?
- Create a birthday card for the next family member's birthday. Try and add a rhyming poem in the middle.
- Write a menu for a special celebration. It could be Christmas dinner or a wedding feast.

Curriculum Learning Projects - to be done throughout the week

This project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to learn more about celebrations. Learning may focus on different types of celebrations that take place and who may celebrate them. It could look at how people celebrate different events differently in other parts of the world.

What does celebration mean to you ?

Make an A-Z list of celebrations around the world. How many can they find? What have they celebrated this year with their friends and family? Can they remember celebrating their birthday? How did they celebrate their birthday? Could they draw a picture of their special celebration? Can they interview a family member about their favourite celebration? What did they do? Who can they remember?

Moorthorpe Key Stage 1 Bake off!

Weigh out the ingredients and bake a cake for a celebration. Can they write the instructions and send them to their teacher? Can they send a photo of their cake to be put on class dojo?

Months:

Can your child name the months in order? What do they notice about them? (Look at the letters at the beginning of the month.) Can they think of a celebration for each month they may have with their family? Find out when it's people's birthdays or anniversaries. Which month has the most celebrations?

Seasons:

Ask your child how many seasons we have? Can they name them?

Ask them to look outside their window and see if they can name the season we are in at the moment. What can they see? Can they see any flowers? Or new buds? Can they draw a picture of what they can see using different materials?

Collect some materials to create a Seasons Calendar. Think about the design and what they will need.
